

## Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA) DECLARATION

**Raltron / RAMI Technology** hereby declares that there are no toxic Substances in our products and that we fully comply with the EPA Toxic Substance Control Act.

On June 22, 2016, the Frank R. Lautenberg Chemical Safety for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Act (Lautenberg Chemical Safety Act), was signed into law. On January 6, 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published final rules under Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h) to restrict the importation and use of five persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) chemicals. The final rules took effect on February 5, 2021.

- > <u>DecaBDE</u>, decabromodiphenyl ether, CAS 1163-19-5
- > <u>2,4,6 TTBP</u>, 2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol, CAS 732-26-3
- > <u>HCBD</u>, hexachlorobutadiene, CAS 87-68-3
- > <u>PCTP</u>, pentachlorothiophenol, CAS 133-49-3

We shall monitor all changes to the EPA TSCA and ensure that our products continue to be Compliant with all future requirements and amendments.
